District Online Worship Recording

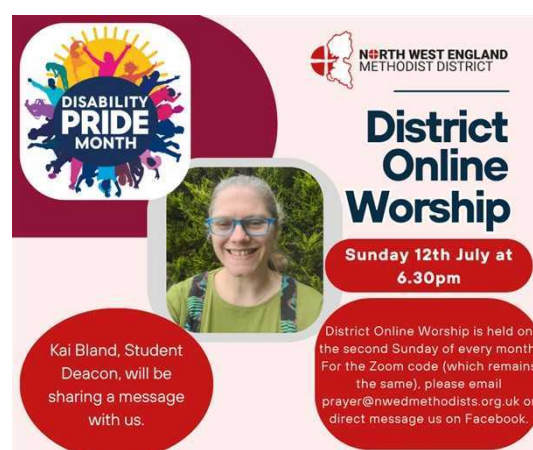
Thank you to everyone that attended our Online Worship on Sunday 14 June.
